Category:SurveyorsHoly Trinity Church, York Holy Trinity Church is an Anglican church in the Church Square at the centre of the city of York, England. The present church building, designed by Joseph Hansom in Romanesque Revival Style and built in 1866-1867, was

consecrated by the Archbishop of York, William John Conolly, on 23 July 1867. It was York's first purpose-built Anglican church in the Gothic style. The original plan of the Church Building Society had called for a church designed in the Arts and Crafts style, but the Archbishop rejected this design and so funds were sought and obtained from a member of the society. Holy Trinity forms part of the United Benefice of York St John, Holy Trinity and St Stephens, with St Stephen's Minster and St John the Evangelist's Church in Bronington. Organ The pipe organ in the north gallery was replaced by a new organ by James Greenwood in 1907. The

present organ was built by Brindley & Foster of London in 1969. A specification of the organ can be found on the National Pipe Organ Register. Organists When the present building opened, the post of organist was held by John Hill (1866–76) and Norman Selfe (1876–80). After the second organist, Ivor Foster, the post was given to Mr J. E. Haines who held it until 1950 when he became organist of York Minster. Also there is mention of a Mr Addison whose son was placed as organist at York Minster. Notable organists who have served Holy Trinity Church since the 1970s have included Pamela Brown (1973–1994), David Walker
